Consultation Proposals

The Annual General Meeting included discussion of
*“building New Dressing Rooms for Football, Bowls and Netball” which
“would enable the current rooms to be converted for the future of the Club”*

Members asked the Management Committee to pursue the possibilities.

Following preliminary consultation with representatives of all sports
these draft proposals include

1 In Stage 1: new cloakrooms for the whole club, providing adequate facilities for all

2 New changing rooms to the standards set out by Sports England and the Football Foundation. They stress the key consideration of inclusivity

“... to champion and support fair access to quality facilities for everyone, regardless of gender, race, disability, or place... safeguarding and security and separate spaces for officials.”

These draft proposals are for multi-use facilities shared by all sports.

3 Changes to provide inclusive access for all and improvement of all fire exits

4 Stage 2 would be the amalgamation of the older changing rooms to provide a flexible space for functions and use as part of the Club

5 This wider, fuller consultation seeks your views on what is these draft proposals, what is to be provided, what included for the longer term and whether it is flexible enough as requirements will inevitably change over time

6 What else would you wish to see in this first, or any future stages?
